### **After Your Internship:**

Our intern program is designed to identify future leaders in health care innovation and delivery at MMG and is intended to be a feeder into our full-time, 3 ½ year Rotational Program. Superstar summer interns may be offered the opportunity to join the Health Care Innovation Trainee Development Program after graduation and start their full-time careers at MMG.

Our program will offer 3 rotations in office, ambulatory surgery center and the local hospital in order to develop well-rounded future innovators. You'll experience and learn what healthcare delivery is like across different functions within MMG and develop a broad understanding of the business model. Additional learning opportunities are available through guest rotations in partner organizations, an extensive training curriculum, and through the support of a peer advisor and mentor.
